Within the Structure of Lifelong Learning, A.U.TH. will undertake a program of Introduction to the Orthodox Tradition under the title, “Learning about Orthodox Theology - Past and Present”.

The aim of the program is to provide an acquaintance with the Orthodox theological tradition, through the use of a diachronic and synchronic approach to Hermeneutics, Dogmatics, Patristics, Ethics, and Church History, concluding with an examination of the Orthodox witness in today’s world. This includes the Patristic Legacy and interpretation in today’s cultural context; Biblical Hermeneutics according to the Patristic tradition in comparison to modern hermeneutical methods; Dogmatic teaching of the Church and creative dialogue with the philosophical thought and the culture; Pluralism, social evolution, and the Orthodox Church; The ethical dimension of the ecological crisis; Bioethical issues; the Christian Homiletic tradition; and, Orthodox Churches in the Ecumenical movement.

The courses will be offered in English and addressed to members of Christian or other faith traditions who wish to gain a global picture of the

Orthodox theological tradition and the dynamic approach of Orthodox societies to the modern world.

The Course is to be taught by professors of the Department of Theology, and "Recognized and Endorsed" by the Structure of Lifelong Learning Program of Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (AUTH) which can grant up to 5 ECTS (European Credits Transfer System) for qualified attendees.

The schedule for the three weeks...

...is the same Monday through Friday: Mornings, 4 (four) 45-minute lecture segments (9:00-10.30, 11.00-12.30), for a total of 60 hours.

1st Week Dogmatics, Sociology, Canon Law, Old Testament

2nd Week New Testament, Patristics, Sociology, Slavonic Orthodox tradition, Ethics

3rd Week Sociology, Orthodox Churches in Multimedia, New Testament, Homiletics, Ecumenical movement, Patristics

The afternoons and the weekends are for **on-site educational excursions** (City tour, Byzantine churches, Archeological and Byzantine museums, Ottoman and Jewish monuments, Cliffs and Monasteries of Meteora, Vergina Macedonian royal tombs, and tracing St Paul's steps in Beroia, Philippi and at Lydia's baptistery, the archeological site of Dion, and Mt Olympus).
