

CALL FOR PARTICIPANTS

for **ToT Culture and Language Learning for Youth** - 2nd to 12th November 2013, Slettestrand, Denmark

By participating in this **Training of Trainers**, youth leaders will have the opportunity to gain an increased understanding of culture and language learning, and an awareness of its importance and how it can be used to nurture the intercultural interaction competence of young people.

The activities will take place over ten days in Slettestrand, Denmark, and bring together twenty four youth leaders from Croatia, Denmark, Greece, Hungary, Romania and Spain. The participants will develop and share tools, knowledge and attitudes for the facilitation of culture and language learning. The aim is to provide more cross-cultural learning projects for young people with enhanced facilitation, thus ensuring a quality experience for the youth who participate in such projects.

Various non-formal learning methods will be used within the program of activities which is designed to encourage reflection, interaction, and peer to peer learning. Types of activity include presentations, both by trainers and participants, group activities and exercises, case studies, discussions and roles plays.

Criteria for participation:

- Young people between 18 and 35 years old, from the countries mentioned above.
- The activities will be conducted in English. Translation will not be provided and the participants are expected to have a good level of English, written as well as spoken.
- Further, the participants must be able to attend the full programme and be highly motivated to participate in the activities.

Candidate applications that do not meet the requirements above will not be considered.

All candidates are required to apply through their national UNA by sending their motivation letter and CV. The motivation letter should contain at least 3 elements that motivate you the most in order to participate and describe in short, why you would like to participate and what you expect from the training.

Participants are ultimately selected by the team of partners. If selected, you will be notified and you will be expected to book your travel arrangements shortly after and provide proof of purchase.

Participation in the activity is for free and food and accommodation is provided. However participants are requested to cover 30% of their own travel expenses. 70% of the travel costs will be reimbursed following the training once all original documents have been received by the coordinators.
